

Border control

Hopefully, many people from all over the world will travel to the COP15-summit in Copenhagen. Unfortunately, we must presume that there will be strict border controls at and around the time of the summit, including denial of entering the country for some people.

We strongly recommend you to bring your passport or form of ID valid for entering Denmark, even though you are travelling from a country member of Schengen. People going to the G8-summit in Rostock in 2008 were checked at the Danish/German border and people not possessing a passport or other valid ID were immediately sent back. We expect the same to happen during the COP15.

In order to support those comrades travelling to the the summit there will be obstacle- at -the- border- crossing -points in Flensburg, Rostock and Malmö.

We want to help those people who may encounter any problems entering Denmark by means of a legal teams, info-telephones and contact points at the mentioned cities. We also presume that some protesters will be deported for some reason or other. If any deported people should arrive near Flensburg, Rostock or Malmö please notify the info points. At your arrival there will be tea or coffee, something to eat and/or somewhere to sleep.

SMS service for people flying to Copenhagen

Since a physical border watch at the airport is difficult to realize and probably not helpful, we will set up a SMS service for people coming by airplane as an alternative for borderwatch.

If you go by plane to Copenhagen, you can send a textmessage before your departure to the border watch group in Copenhagen. After landing and passing the security in Copenhagen you will send a second textmessage to the border watch, so they know you arrived safe. In case you get arrested in Denmark and we cant get in contact with you, you can be sure that legal aid group will be informed.

If you decide to send an SMS please make sure:

- That your telephone works in Denmark (otherwise we can not get in touch with you after you have arrived in Copenhagen and you will be listed as “arrested”)
- Please send your name and a time when you expect to send the second SMS to report your safe arrival before you check in.
- THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT THING:
PLEASE SEND A SECOND SMS WHEN YOU ARRIVED SAFE IN
COPENHAGEN!!! IF WE DONT GET A SECOND SMS WE ASSUME YOU GOT
ARRESTED!!!
